Residents and businesses may drop recyclables off at the Borough Recycling Center (on Fairview Avenue next to the Borough Garage), or hold them until the next scheduled recycling day.

Residential Miscellaneous Paper Curbside Collection

Includes glossy papers, magazines, office paper, school papers, envelopes, junk mail, greeting cards, gift wrapping paper, paperback books, chipboard (gift boxes and cereal boxes). This collection is held once a month as follows:

Zone 1	First Friday of the month
Zone 2	Second Friday of the month
Zone 3	Third Friday of the month

If a holiday falls on your collection zone schedule, miscellaneous paper may be held for the following month or taken to the Borough Recycling Center located at the Borough Garage on Fairview Avenue and deposited in the appropriate bin.

Business Recycling

The following information and schedule applies to Little Silver businesses only:

Monday Collections: Cardboard only. All cardboard must be dry, flattened, and securely tied in bundles no larger than 5 feet by 5 feet. Waxed cardboard is not recyclable.

Note — Corrugated Cardboard Collection: When a Borough Holiday falls on a Monday, corrugated cardboard will be collected the next day (Tuesday).

Friday Collections: Glass, cans, plastics, newspaper, and miscellaneous paper. Miscellaneous paper should be placed in plastic bags and tied. Newspapers must be bundled and tied securely.
