## From Police Department

### **HOLIDAY ONLINE SHOPPING TIPS**

- Secure your computer.** Make sure it has the latest security updates and is receiving automatic anti-virus/anti-spyware updates.
- Ignore pop-up messages.** Set your browser to block them. If one is received, click on the "X" at the top right corner of the title bar to close it.
- Use strong passwords, never share them.** Use at least eight characters, with numbers, characters, and upper and lower case letters.
- Do not e-mail sensitive data.** Never e-mail credit card or other financial/sensitive information. E-mail is like mailing a postcard - anyone can see it!
- Do not use public computers or public wireless to conduct transactions.** Criminals may be monitoring public wireless for credit card numbers and other confidential information.
- Review privacy policies.** Know what information the merchant is collecting, how it will be used, and if it will be shared or sold to others.
- Make payments securely.** Pay by credit card, not debit card. Credit card transactions are protected. If online criminals obtain your debit card information, they have the potential to empty your bank account.
- Select merchants carefully.** Limit online shopping to merchants you know and trust. Confirm the online seller's physical address and phone number in case you have questions or problems.
- Keep a record.** Keep a record of online transactions, including the product description and price, the online receipt, and copies of e-mails sent or received from sellers. Review credit card and bank statements for unauthorized charges.

If you have problems shopping online, contact the seller or site operator directly. If those attempts are not successful, you may wish to contact:

## DOG & CAT LICENSES DUE JANUARY 31

During the month of January, Borough Ordinance requires the licensing of all dogs and cats. Licenses can be obtained at the Borough Clerk's office, Monday through Friday, 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Cat and dog owners who fail to obtain or renew a license by January 31 will be subject to a \$5 late fee.

The State requires each municipality to conduct a dog census in the Spring. Pet owners who have not obtained a license by that time will be issued a summons by the Police Department, which carries a \$20 fine. If you no longer own a dog or cat, contact the Borough Clerk's Office at 732-842-2400, leave your name and address so it can be removed from the computer.

### Licensing Instructions

**Fees:** \$11 for dogs/cat not spayed or neutered  
 \$ 8 for dogs/cats spayed or neutered  
 Submit veterinarian's certificate of spaying or neutering, and proof of rabies inoculation.

**PROOF OF RABIES INOCULATION MUST BE SUBMITTED.** Dog owners: Rabies expiration date must be good through October of this year.

*NOTE: Borough auditor requires separate banking accounts for dogs and cats. Therefore, when submitting your payment, please write a separate check for dogs and cats.*

# SHADE TREE COMMISSION

## Winter Tree Protection



Harsh winter weather can result in problems, even for trees that are dormant. It's especially important to offer young trees and recent transplants some care and winter protection. Extreme cold, harsh wind and bright sun can stress trees, and cause bark splitting that exposes and separates tender new wood just beneath, as well as dieback and browning of leaves. Winter damaged trees are more vulnerable to disease and insects. A few tips to help prepare trees for winter:

- A 2-3 inch layer of mulch of chopped leaves, pine needles, aged wood chips, or purchased mulch products helps protect roots from the damaging effects of freezing and thawing.
- Water young trees deeply up until the first hard frost, especially if rain has been minimal.
- Snow accumulation on branches of evergreen shrubs and conifer trees can cause the branches to bend. Generally, the branches will return to normal by leaving the snow to melt. If there is a large accumulation and you want to remove the snow, use a soft brush or broom, brushing upward from underneath the branch. Do not brush the snow in a downward motion or knock the snow off, as this may break the branch.
- If ice coats the branches of evergreen shrubs, confers or leafless deciduous tree, do not attempt to remove the ice. You will do more damage than good! Let the ice melt naturally. As it does, a healthy branch usually regains resiliency and returns to normal position. The added water on branches is good for evergreens and conifer.
- Check tree bases for signs of small animals chewing or deer rubbing. While these often do not cause permanent damage, it can leave it susceptible to insects and disease. In extreme cases, wrapping tree trunks in burlap or mesh screening can help prevent damage. Do not use wound sealer or other products that restrict air and light.

## Reminder: LEAF COLLECTION

Leaves only may be placed to curb until December 31. ***If other debris is mixed in with leaves, they will not be collected.*** Branch and limb collection resumes in January.

**LIVE CHRISTMAS TREES,  
GREETING CARDS,  
WRAPPING PAPER**

Remove all tinsel and place tree to the curb. Do not put trees in plastic bags. The Public Works

Recycling Crew will collect the tree. It will be taken to a recycling facility, where it will be chipped. Place to the curb according to the new 2010 Brush/Limb Schedule.



Greeting cards and wrapping paper should be recycled with "miscellaneous paper", in a 30-gallon clear plastic bag, placed to the curb on "miscellaneous paper" collection day. Miscellaneous paper can also be taken to the Recycling Center at the Department of Public Works Garage on Fairview Avenue.

## **Inclement Weather**

---

**This information applies to residential and business recycling.** Recyclables will be collected rain or shine. In the event of severe weather (e.g., a snowstorm or hurricane), recyclables will not be collected. Residents and businesses may drop recyclables off at the Borough Recycling Center (on Fairview Avenue next to the Borough Garage), or hold them until the next scheduled recycling day.

## **Business Recycling — 2010**

---

**The following information and schedule applies to Little Silver businesses only:**

**Monday Collections:** Cardboard only. All cardboard must be dry, flattened, and securely tied in bundles no larger than 5 feet by 5 feet. Waxed cardboard and Korean cardboard are not recyclable.

**Note — Corrugated Cardboard Collection:** When a Borough Holiday falls on a Monday, corrugated cardboard will be collected the next day (Tuesday).

**Friday Collections:** Glass, cans, plastics, newspaper, and miscellaneous paper. Miscellaneous paper should be placed in plastic bags and tied. Newspapers must be bundled and tied securely.
