

OPERATION MEDICINE CABINET

On Saturday, November 14, 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m., the Little Silver Police Department will join other Police Departments throughout New Jersey in the participation in "Operation Medicine Cabinet". This program will provide New Jersey residents the opportunity to rid their medicine cabinets of their unused, unwanted and expired medicines. These medicines should be brought to Borough Hall, 480 Prospect Avenue, and turned over to a law enforcement official who can, in turn, dispose of these controlled substances in a safe and nonhazardous manner.

More than 70% of people who abuse prescription painkillers say they get them from family or friends. Usually this occurs without the knowledge and consent of the patient to whom the medication was prescribed. Dispose of the medicines and keep them out of the hands of our children.

Recycling Reminders



BRANCH AND LIMB COLLECTION

Residents are reminded that placement to the curb of limbs and branches has ended for the season.

Leaves only may be placed to the curb for collection.

Brush and limb collection will resume in January according to the 2010 placement to the curb schedule, which will be available in the December Newsletter.

LEAVES MAY BE RAKED TO THE CURB UNTIL DECEMBER 31

When raking leaves to the curb, please make sure no other debris is mixed in with the leaves. The farm site where Little Silver disposes the leaves is under strict regulations from NJ DEP.

If other debris is mixed in with leaves, they will not be collected.

RECYCLING DROP-OFF CENTER

The Recycling Drop-Off Center is located behind the Borough Garage on Fairview Avenue. Hours of operation are:

Monday - Friday 8:00 am - 2:00 pm
Saturday 8:00 am - 12:00 noon

Residents are encouraged to take recyclables to the Recycling Center. Please note that corrugated cardboard must be now be recycled with newspapers on the scheduled recycling day, or taken to the Recycling Center. Please see the "2009 Recycling Update" for details on recycling.

REMINDER: RECYCLE CARDBOARD

Corrugated cardboard is to be recycled. Boxes must be flattened and tied in small bundles. Cardboard may be placed to the curb, along with newspapers, on scheduled newspaper recycling collection dates. Cardboard will not be picked up with trash collection.

Little Silver Police have already tested, approved and are using this service. For easy registration, sign up now at www.nixle.com. After signing on, go to your account/settings and check both "The Borough of Little Silver" and "community alerts." With that being completed, you will be notified when any recreation sport or event is cancelled. It's so simple even a caveman can use it!

Playing with Age/Grade Appropriate Level

Regardless of skill level, all participants in recreation sports must play at their appropriate age/grade level. Except for older boy's baseball, grouping is according to grade. "Playing up" is prohibited and if a parent deliberately registers and plays his child in an older age/grade level or provides false date of birth information, that child will be prohibited from playing for that season. "Playing down" under certain circumstances may be allowed if a request is made in writing by a parent and approved by the league director.


