- Of course, all questions may not apply to all children – Feel free to substitute information that may be necessary.
- If your child is in preschool – use their preschool information for teacher and grade areas. Or if they are even younger, Santa might say “How do you like helping Mommy & Daddy? I understand you’ve been doing very well with your chores!”
- The section that begins...“Will you do me a big favor” is where the Santa can help the parents with a particular challenge the child is having. Santa can encourage them to do items such as clean their room, care for their pet, stop talking back, not hit their sibling, etc.
